A brief description of each role is below:

- *Church Council*

This is the Trustee body that is responsible for the running of Wesley Ebenezer Methodist Church (which is made up of both Wesley Hall and Walkley Ebenezer). The Church Council meets quarterly to hear reports and decide upon larger items of policy and expenditure.

- *Wesley Hall Leadership Team*

The Wesley Hall Leadership Team meet monthly to pray, share ideas and plan/review church events.

- *Worship Steward*

Worship Stewards look after the practical side of our Sunday worship. This involves liaising with preachers during the week, finding readers for the service and looking after the preacher on Sunday morning.
